The following are appointed to the Personnel Committee: Joshua, Luis, Eleanor, Ruby L and India. India was appointed Committee Chair.
  4. The School's Anti-Bullying Charter was discussed. The Council agreed that they supported the Charter and the Chair should sign it on behalf of pupils. Mr. Thacker signed the Charter on behalf of staff. The Chair of Governors will sign the document this Thursday.
  5. A copy of Collective Worship themes for the Autumn Term was shared with the Council. There was discussion about some of the themes and special events coming up. It was agreed that each class should have a copy on display.
